

Talks stall with Town's outside workers

Negotiations between the Town of Halton Hills and CUPE Local #73 have stalled, and will require the assistance of a labour conciliator.

Town Chief Administrative Officer Dennis Perlin said negotiations were adjourned Wednesday.

Union president Andy Garbutt said Thursday that a union vote will be held on Thursday, Jan. 24 to go to a conciliator. If the vote is affirmative, a request will be made to the Ministry of Labour to appoint a conciliator to work on the remaining issues such as salary and benefits.

Garbutt said he believes a conciliator will be

available right away and he hopes the issues will be resolved fairly quickly.

CUPE #73 involves about 42 Town's outside employees, such as snowplow drivers, roads and parks workers, and facility attendants at the arenas, Civic Centre and Gellert Community Centre. Facility attendants clean and set up the facilities and prepare the ice surfaces and pools.

If conciliation is unsuccessful, Perlin said, the workers could be in a position to strike. Under Ontario labour law, workers can be in a strike position 17 days after a "no board" decision is declared by conciliator.


