Valentine's Day reminds us of the things we love – family, friends and chocolate.

Chocolate is made with milk, which is produced by farmers, many of whom are in the Greenbelt. Regardless of their product -- dairy, livestock, fruits and vegetables -- farmers look to the successful Greenbelt Farm Stewardship Program to help them improve their environmentally friendly farm practices.

The Program has been granted \$2.4 million by the Friends of the Greenbelt Foundation, a non-profit organization committed to creating leading and innovative practices that make the world a better, healthier place to live.

"This Program is world-leading and was created by Ontario farmers," says Shelley Petrie of the Greenbelt Foundation. "It recognizes that farmers need clean water and healthy soils to farm. We all benefit from farmers taking action to protect and improve the environment and the land."

With 480 completed projects to date, farmers in the Program have protected the quality of source water by erecting fences around ponds and stream banks, planting 20,000 trees for clean air, reducing the volume of pesticides sprayed annually on participating fruit acreage by 30%, and creating safe and secure storage of fertilizer and livestock manure.

"Farmers' concern for the land is important to the Greenbelt and Ontarians," says Petrie.

The Greenbelt, 1.8 million acres of protected land wrapping around the Golden Horseshoe, includes over 7,000 farms protected from development. Greenbelt farmers produce over 100 varieties of vegetables, all types of meat, fruits, specialty products like herbs and honey -- and milk for chocolate -- for you and your loved ones!



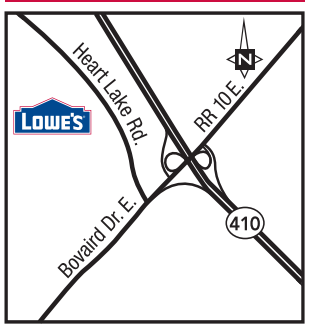
