The 2008 World Day of Prayer will be held on Friday, March 7, at 7:30 p.m. at St. Andrew's United Church, 89 Mountainview Rd. S., Georgetown.

The World Day of Prayer is observed annually on the first Friday of March. It is an invitation for Christians to pause and pray together ecumenically. The Women's Inter-Church Council of Canada and its national counterparts around the world sponsor the event. It is celebrated in more than 170 countries around the world and 2,000 communities across Canada.

This year, the service has been written by the women of Guyana, with the theme, God's Wisdom Provides New Understanding.

The Cooperative Republic of Guyana is located on the northern coast of South

America; it is the only English-speaking country on the continent. Poverty, violence against women and the increasing number of women infected by HIV/AIDS are the major issues affecting a significant proportion of the Guyanese population. The government, church, faith-based communities and civic and non-governmental organizations are working to

improve these social conditions.

Guest speaker will be Rev. Dr. Margaret Roberts from Guyana.
