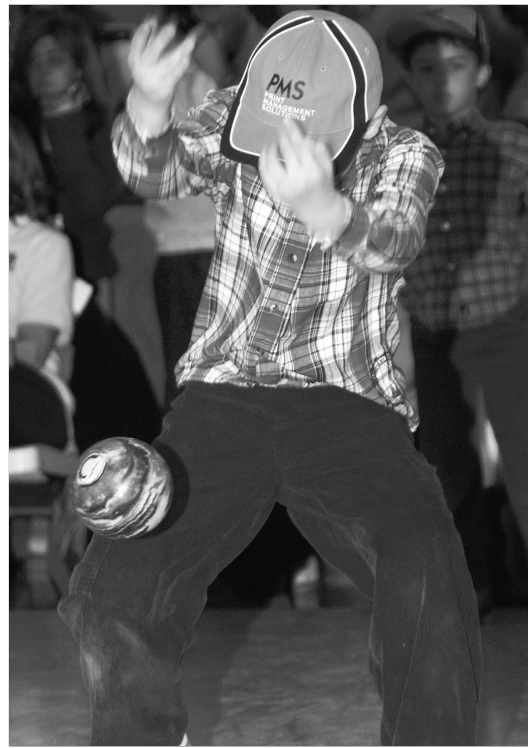


Having a bowl

Train derailment quickly cleaned up

He said some of the cars, that were located about 47 cars from the front of the 147-rail car train, were empty, while some contained freight, and one was an empty container car that previously had held a dangerous commodity.

A spokesperson for Halton Hills Fire Department said the car had previously contained sulphuric acid. It was inspected by both CN and Halton Hills Fire Protection and Prevention Services Hazardous Materials team

and deemed safe as there had been no breach of the car's walls and monitoring equipment showed no toxic fumes.

Due to the derailment, GO Transit cancelled all of its trains on the Georgetown line Wednesday morning, except for two trains from Mount Pleasant and another from Brampton. Trains were cancelled again Wednesday evening.

VIA Rail service between Toronto and Sarnia, with stops in Georgetown, was also impacted and alternate arrangements were made for passengers.

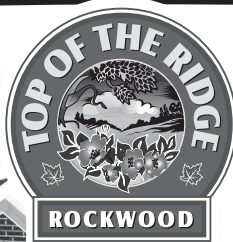

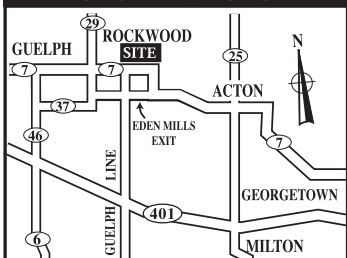
