Just Chicken

Ingredients

- 12 chicken drumsticks (bone in, skin on or off—whichever you prefer)
- 2 tbsp Dijon mustard
- 3 tbsp vinegar
- 1/2 tsp dried rosemary
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tbsp brown sugar
- 2 tsp dried oregano
- 1 tsp pepper
- 1/4 cup olive oil



Method

Mix all dressing ingredients, whisking in olive oil last. Place chicken in a Ziploc bag and pour dressing ingredients in with it. Seal well. Refrigerate chicken at least one hour or overnight.

To bake, place chicken in a baking dish and pour marinade over top. Sprinkle with a pinch or two of salt. Bake at 350 degrees for 45-60 minutes, uncovered, or until chicken is tender and cooked through. Serves six.
