Ceremony honours both veteran and new firefighters

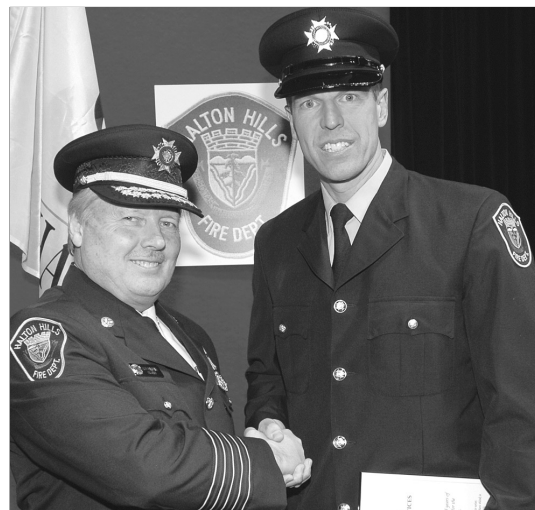
Several long-time Halton Hills firefighters were recently recognized for their years of service and 14 new recruits received their graduation certificates at John Elliott Theatre.

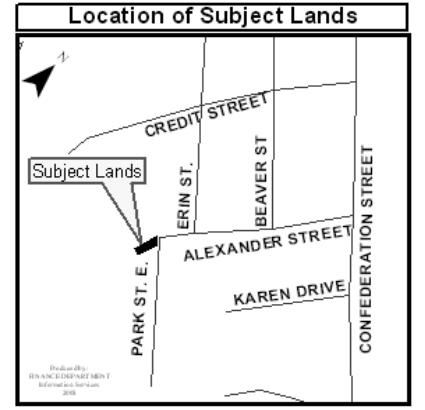
