Georgetown, Brampton men face charges

Two men, one from Georgetown, are facing charges in connection with the theft of a pickup truck and break and enters in the Dufferin County and Haliburton/Midland area report Dufferin OPP.

Police say just prior to midnight Saturday OPP responded to an abandoned vehicle in the rural area north of Shelburne.

While police were investigating, two men jumped in the vehicle and sped off ignoring police commands to stop.

The vehicle left the area and was driven into a ditch where the two men fled on foot. Police say the two men then stole a pickup truck from a nearby home and on Sunday Peel Police located the truck and arrested the two suspects.

Investigation revealed the men were responsible for four break-ins.

Facing numerous charges resulting from the break, enter and thefts are Eugene Pereverzev, 21, of Logan Ct., Georgetown and Andrew Townsend, 20, of Caruso Dr., Brampton.

Town hoping for Earth Hour participation

The purpose of Earth Hour is to increase public awareness of the need to decrease energy use and take action on climate change. It originated in Australia last year when more than 2.2 million people and 2,100 businesses took part.

This year, the Town will turn off all non-essential lights, without jeopardizing public safety, at its facilities. Due to the timing of Earth Hour, most of the buildings will be closed with lights off anyways. However at the arenas where the minor hockey Day of Champs is ongoing, only the non-necessary lights will be turned off (as normal practice).

Similarly lights will not be turned off at the Hornby Community Centre where a euchre club plays. However, lights at parks and outdoor rinks will be turned off for one hour, as will lights on the Eighth Line pathway from Maple Avenue to the Gellert Centre.

A budget of \$2,000 has been set aside to promote the event, and the Town will begin planning a bigger and better Earth Hour in 2009 after reviewing this year's initiative.

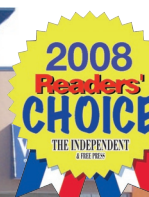

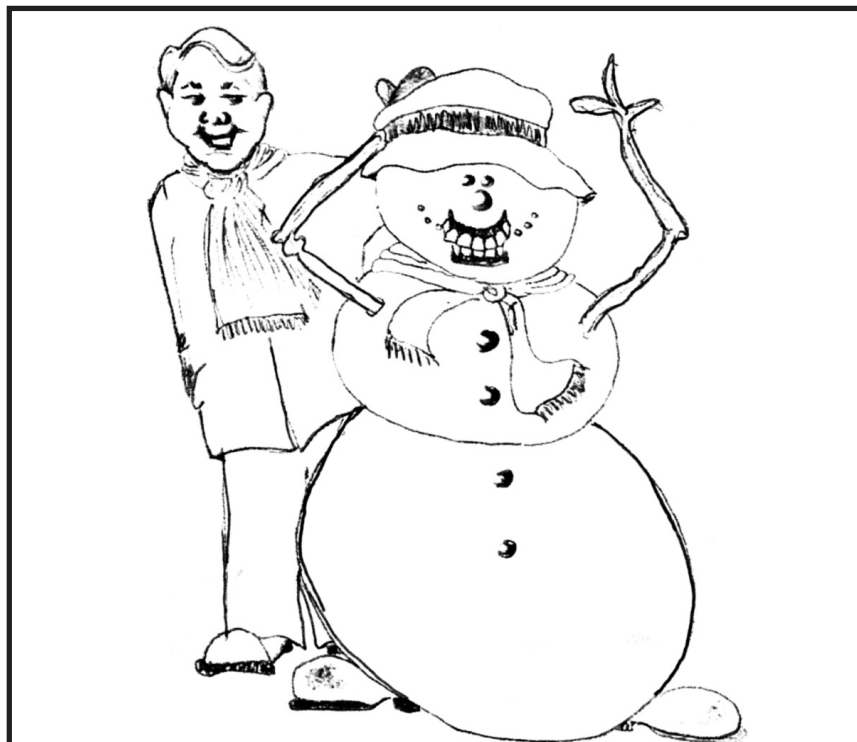
