Flooding makes a mess of roads

The spring thaw earlier in the week meant some inconvenience for area drivers and kept Town of Halton Hills public works crews busy when melting snow washed out several roads and caused part of the bank on 15 Sideroad near Eighth Line to slide onto the road.

Dick Spear, the Town's Superintendent of Public Works, said Sixth Line, just south of Steeles Ave. near the entrance to Hornby Park, had to be closed Tuesday night through Wednesday afternoon because Sixteen Mile Creek overflowed across both Sixth Line and Steeles Ave.

The shoulders were washed away
