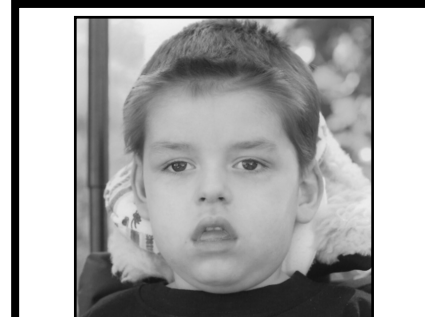
DUTCHBURN, Mildred Viola (nee Turnbull)
