## Locals run Marathon

A half-dozen Georgetown residents took up the 26-mile challenge with over 27,000 other entrants to race in the Boston Marathon last week.

About 5,000 of the athletes were unable to finish the hilly course under warm conditions in Beantown.

James Warnock, 38, was the fastest local finisher in a time of three hours, 36 minutes and 24 seconds, good for 8,335th overall, just ahead of Georgetown's Mark Rush, 51, who checked in at 3:36:31.

Also completing the 112th running of the event were Sheldon Gragg (3:52:23), Claudine Waddick (3:56:04), Brenda Hamilton (4:20:50) and Betty D'Oliveira (4:21:22).

Georgetown's main camp doesn't get started until August.

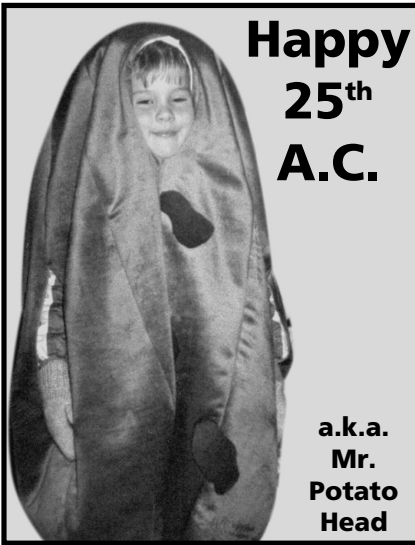

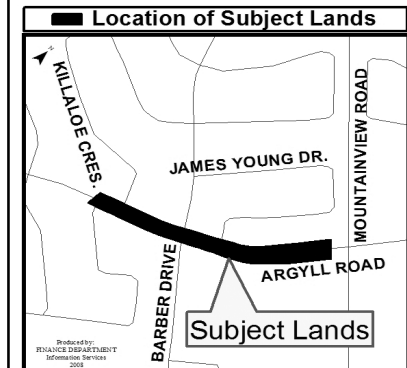

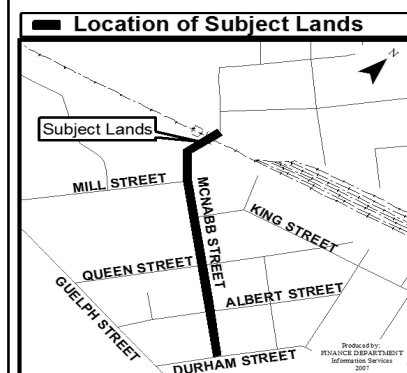
## NOTICE OF STREET NAME CHANGE
