We would like to encourage everyone to be Water Wise, a little conservation by all of us can make a significant difference. Here are some lawn care tips:

- Plant water efficient, drought tolerant plants.
- Use a rain gauge on your lawn to measure how much rain you're received and if you even need to water. Pick up your free rain gauge at Halton Region's main office or your Local Municipal office;
- Set your mower blade to 6.5 to 7.5 centimetres (2 1/2 to 3 inches) high Taller grass shades the roots and helps the soil stay moist.

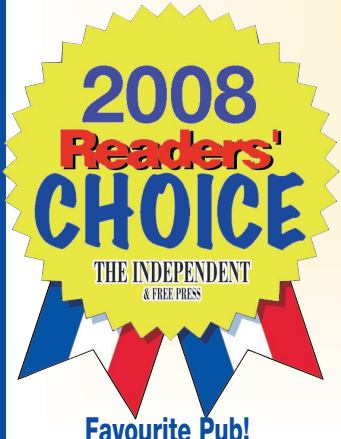
