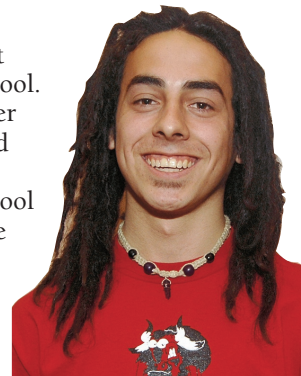
## Saveena Loch

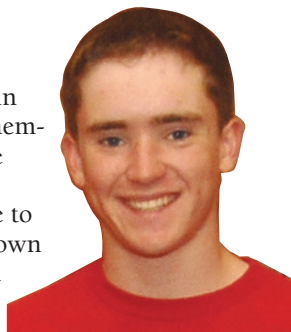
## Alexandra Holtom
