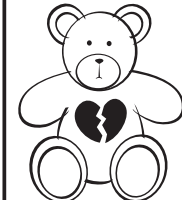
The Georgetown Rebels and Christ the King Jaguars advanced to Thursday's second round of Halton playoffs after opening the post-season with wins on Tuesday.
