Brampton man charged after crack cocaine found in car

A Brampton man is facing a drug charge after police seized about eight grams of crack cocaine with a street value of about \$800 from a vehicle in the Mill St./Cross St. area of Georgetown Tuesday afternoon.

Charged with possession of a controlled substance is Huntley Mclarty, 36, of Hansen Rd. N.

A 37-year-old Georgetown man has been charged with assault and mischief

to property in connection with an incident involving his female partner in a Georgetown residence early Sunday morning.

Police do not release the names of people charged in domestic incidents to protect the identity of the victim.

Approximately \$1,000 damage was caused to a vehicle parked at a Danville Ave. Acton residence when an object was thrown at it sometime late Saturday

or early Sunday.

Police report someone broke into Georgetown High School at about 6:40 Sunday evening setting off the alarm at the school. A fire extinguisher was discharged in a hallway.

Three unlocked vehicles at residences on Durham St. were entered and change was stolen early Saturday morning.

At about 1:30 a.m. a woman saw some people going through some backyards on Durham St., and then later saw two males riding their bikes on Union St. and stopping to check the doors of vehicles.

A 2003 Honda parked on Gooderham Dr. was stolen sometime early Wednesday morning.

The vehicle is valued at \$5,000.

DEVELOPMENT CHARGES ACT, 1997 S.O. 1997, c. 27

NOTICE OF THE PASSING OF BY-LAW NO. 62-08, BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH WATER, WASTEWATER, ROADS AND GENERAL SERVICES DEVELOPMENT CHARGES FOR THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON (HUSP/NON-HUSP) AND TO REPEAL DEVELOPMENT CHARGES BY-LAW NOS. 102-03, 57-04 and 99-04 AS AMENDED AND TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 100-04.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of The Regional Municipality of Halton passed By-law No. 62-08 on the 28th of May, 2008 under the *Development Charges Act, 1997* (the "Act") which establishes water, wastewater, roads and general services development charges for the Regional Municipality of Halton (HUSP/Non-HUSP), and repeals By-law Nos. 102-03, 57-04 and 99-04 as amended and repeals By-law No. 100-04.

This By-law No. 62-08 comes into force on the 18th day of August, 2008.

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal this By-law to the Ontario Municipal Board under section 14 of the Act by filing with **the Clerk of The Regional Municipality of Halton, 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 3L1 / fax: 905-825-8838** not later than 4:30 p.m. on the **7th day of July, 2008**, a written notice of appeal setting out the objection to the By-law and the reasons supporting the objection.

The complete By-law is available for examination at the Clerk's office 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 3L1 during regular office hours, 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday. An explanation of the development charges imposed and a description of the lands to which the By-law applies are set out below.

OVERVIEW

By-law No. 62-08 establishes updated area specific (HUSP/Non-HUSP) water and wastewater development charges and region-wide roads and general services (being growth studies, police, emergency medical services, services for seniors, facilities and social housing) development charges and repeals By-law Nos. 102-03, 54-07 and 99-04 as amended and By-law No. 100-04.

The HUSP Urban and Rural Residential Development Charges are shown on Schedule "B-1" of the By-law, the Non-HUSP Urban and Rural Residential Development Charges are shown on Schedule "B-2" of the By-law, the HUSP Urban and Rural Non-Residential Development Charges are shown on Schedule "C-1" of the By-law, and the Non-HUSP Urban and Rural Non-Residential Development Charges are shown on Schedule "C-2" of the By-law, all of which are attached to this notice.

LANDS AFFECTED

This By-law applies to all lands in the geographic area of the Regional Municipality of Halton. A key map, being Schedule "A" of the By-law, is attached.

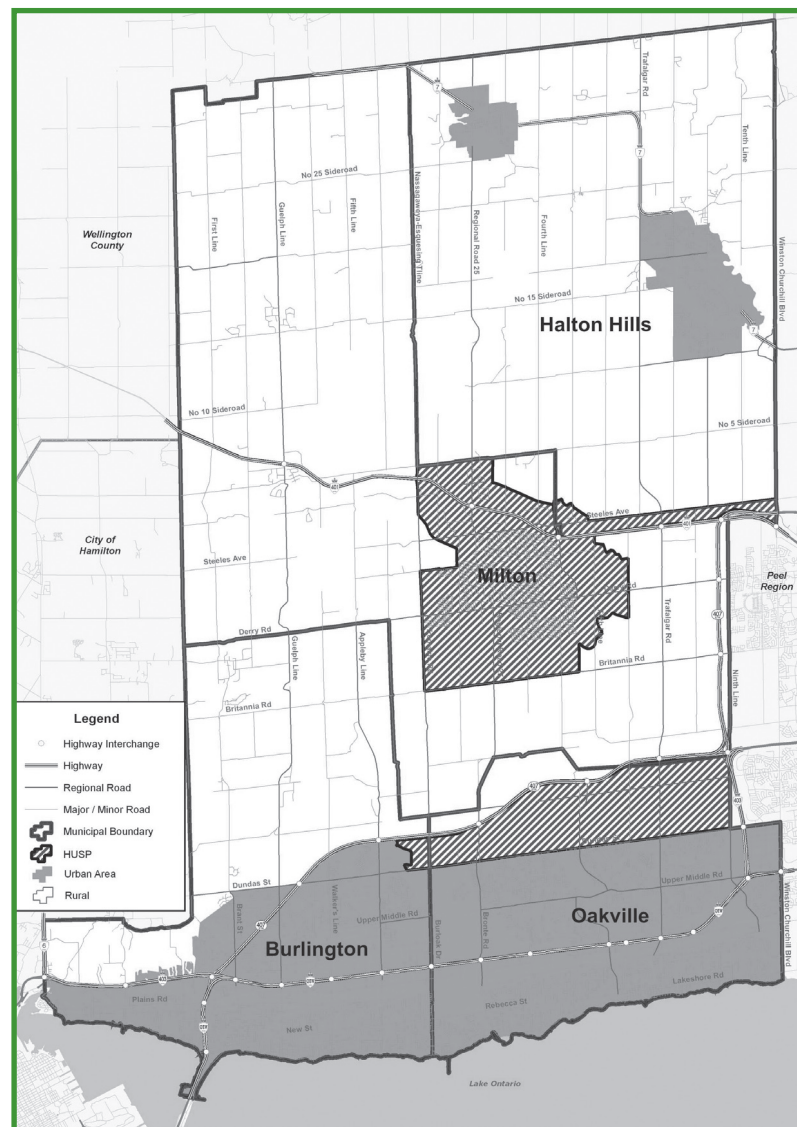
The development of land in the Region may be subject to one or more development charge by-laws of the Region.
