NOTICE TO HALTON HILLS TAXPAYERS

The first instalment of the 2008 Final Tax Bill is due on:

Thursday, June 26, 2008

PAYMENT OF TAXES

WHERE?

- Finance Department, Civic Centre (8:30 – 4:30 Monday to Friday), or
- Any branch of the Royal Bank located within the Town of Halton Hills (may be subject to a service charge)
- Payments may be left at the Halton Hills Hydro Office (no receipts issued)

AFTER HOURS?

- Royal Bank branches during scheduled hours of service
- Drop Box located next to main entrance of Civic Centre available 24 hours

HOW?

- By CHEQUE or CASH
- POST-DATED cheques are acceptable and will ensure that instalment dates are not missed
- INTERAC – in person at the Civic Centre
- By TELEPHONE or COMPUTER: Check with your bank for further information
- PRE-AUTHORIZED PAYMENT PLAN: For details please call the Tax Department at 905-873-2601, ext. 2930

LATE PAYMENTS?

- A late payment charge of 1-1/4 per cent per month will be charged on the first day of each calendar month until taxes are paid

NO TAX BILL?

- Bills were mailed May 30th, 2008. Failure to receive a Tax Bill does not excuse the Owner from responsibility for payment, nor relieve him/her from liability for late payment charges. Please contact the Finance Department if you did not receive yours.

NEW PROPERTIES?

- Newly built properties are likely to have tax bills related to their land value assessment only until full assessment is applied and supplementary taxes are billed. Owners are responsible for taxes billed and should make provisions for the future billing of supplementary taxes.

SENIOR'S TAX GRANT?

- To qualify for the Senior's Tax Grant applicants must be 65 years of age, own and occupy property in the Town of Halton Hills for one year and be in receipt of the Guaranteed Income Supplement. Applications are available from the Tax Department and will automatically be mailed to those who qualified last year.

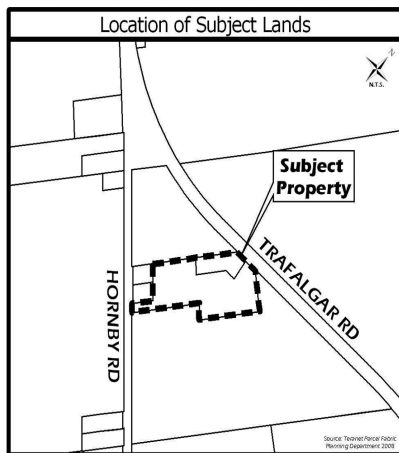

Concerning Application to Amend the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law For lands legally described as Part of Lot 2, Concession 8, Town of Halton Hills and municipally known as 8285 Hornby Road & 8300 Trafalgar Road Town of Halton Hills (Esquensing)

General Committee for the Town of Halton Hills will conduct a Public Meeting to examine and discuss the proposed amendment application to the Town of Halton Hills Zoning By-law 74-51, as amended. The proposed amendment applies to the property known as Part of Lot 2, Concession 8 and municipally known as 8285 Hornby Road and 8300 Trafalgar Road, Town of Halton Hills (Esquensing). The subject property is located in the rural cluster of Hornby.

Below is a map showing the location of the subject property to which the proposed Zoning By-law amendment would apply.



The proposed Zoning By-law Amendment would change the zoning of the property from "Rural" (RU) to "Rural - Special" (RU-1). The proposed amendment would allow a Group Home Type 1 at the property for persons with developmental disabilities. A Group Home Type 1 is a permitted use within the "Rural" zoning district, however, the Zoning By-law requires that they be located a minimum of 1000m from a Group Home Type 2. The proposed Group Home Type 1 would be located 390m from the nearest Group Home Type 2. The proposed amendment would also allow an associated day program for approximately 30 people, including residents of the property.

If you wish to be notified of the decision of the Town of Halton Hills in respect of this proposed Zoning By-law Amendment, you must make a written request to the Town of Halton Hills – PLANNING & DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT at 1 Halton Hills Drive, Halton Hills, Ontario L7G 5G2.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of Council of the Town of Halton Hills to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting, or make written submissions to the Town of Halton Hills before the by-law is passed, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

NOTE: Any written comments/objections submitted to the Town of Halton Hills regarding this Application(s) which is being processed under the Planning Act 1990, may be made public as part of the application process.

CAST IRON WATERMAIN REPLACEMENT AND SANITARY SEWER REPLACEMENT AND ROAD REHABILITATION AND STORM SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN THE ACTON BOULEVARD AREA, TOWN OF HALTON HILLS (ACTON) P-2008-C-01A

Halton Region is proposing cast iron watermain replacements on the following streets:

- Mill Street East from Young Street to Acton Boulevard
- Acton Boulevard from Mill Street to Queen Street
- Peel Street from Young Street to Wellington Street
- Perth Street from CN Tracks to Wallace Street

In conjunction with the watermain replacements, sanitary sewers will also be replaced on the following streets:

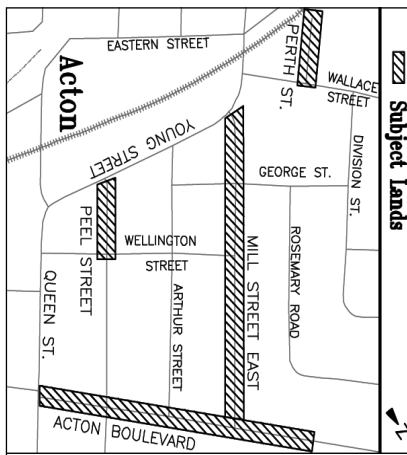
- Mill Street East from Wellington Street to Acton Boulevard
- Peel Street from Young Street to Wellington Street
- Perth Street from CN Tracks to Wallace Street

The Town of Halton Hills is also proposing road and storm sewer construction along with curb and sidewalk repair/installation on the following streets:

- Acton Boulevard from Mill Street to Queen Street
- Mill Street East from Wellington Street to Acton Boulevard
- Peel Street from Young Street to Wellington Street
- Perth Street from CN Tracks to Wallace Street

A joint Public Information Centre will be held to provide residents with an opportunity to review the project drawings and to discuss any potential construction impacts that may result from the proposed works.
