

Expensive gas? It's the new reality

Reducing your gas consumption

Car owners who cared little about the maintenance of their vehicles in the past had better change their ways in the future. Until just recently, wasting fuel was nearly a national sport. According to Natural Resources Canada, Canadian motorists will probably burn an extra 643 million litres of fuel this year, only because one or more of their tires are under-inflated. So the first step toward better fuel economy will be to better monitor the pressure of our tires which has to be checked often and maintained according to the manufacturer's recommendation (check your owner's manual).

A new approach to driving



About 643 million litres of fuel will be wasted this year, due only to under-inflated tires.

Drivers will have to adopt a new approach to driving. Repeat acceleration, and the non-respect of speed limits greatly contribute to high gas consumption.

As well, vehicles will have to be loaded more lightly. Furthermore, drivers will have to keep better track of prevailing gas prices. For instance, we all know that gas prices are increased one or two days prior to a long weekend or just before a legal holiday. Why not plan accordingly and fill-up a few days earlier when prices are lower?

In brief

Proper preparation or a tune-up of the vehicle will also help. However, better monitoring of the tire pressure, lighter loads and better driving habits still won't decrease the price of gas! But all of these factors will make for better fuel economy, which will translate in a smaller gas bill. This is the new reality!


