

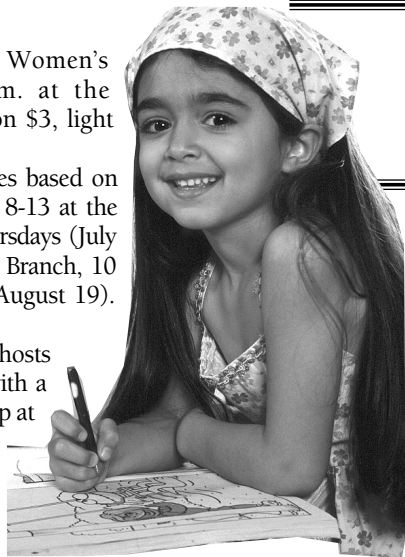
Thursday, July 3
