

Police seek public's help to identify man in assault

Police are asking for help from the public in identifying a man who assaulted a young Georgetown woman Tuesday morning.

Police say shortly after 2 a.m. a 17-year-old left a home on Hewson Cres. and walked to a vehicle parked at the side of the house.

Realizing the vehicle was locked she turned to walk back to the house and was confronted by an unknown man who began to grab and pull at her hair.

The girl struggled with the man before she managed to get back to the house where she notified other people in the home and police were contacted. But the man was gone when police arrived.

The man is described as white, in his 20s, approximately 5'7" with a medium build and chubby stomach, acne and blonde facial hair on his chin and a slight accent of unknown origin. He was wearing a beige Timberland-style boots, a black long-sleeved t-shirt with a basketball and team name on it, dark pants and a light beige hat with ear covers.

Halton Region to construct turning lane at Chudleigh's

It'll be a little easier to pick apples this fall at Chudleigh's Farm on Regional Rd. 25 in Halton Hills.

Halton Region has approved the construction of a northbound left-hand turn lane at the popular tourist location, just south of 10 Sideroad.

The proposed works include widening the existing roadway for the left-turn lane,

improvements at the entrance to Chudleigh's and partial replacement of a culvert north of the entrance. During the construction, which is expected to take place between July and September, the two lanes of traffic will be reduced to one lane. Temporary traffic signals will be set up to direct vehicles.

Halton Region budgeted \$500,000 for the installation of the turn lane.
