Acton Rotary Club contributes final payment on Prospect Park band shell

The project got underway in 2006, with the financial support of the Town of Halton Hills in the form of a loan.

Recently the Club celebrated its 2007-2008 changeover day with a barbecue at the home of Rotarian Dave and Marnie Manes. During this

meeting Councillor Jon Hurst, representing the Town of Halton Hills, accepted a \$19,102.26 cheque from the Rotary Club of Acton which paid off the outstanding balance of the loan from the Town. The band shell cost more than \$100,000.

It is coincidental that the first function held at the Rotary Band Shell was the 2007 Canada Day celebrations and the first function to be held at the debt-free Rotary Band Shell was this year's Canada Day celebrations.
