Halton Waste Management Site



The Halton Waste Management Site (HWMS) is Halton's "one stop" solution for the 3Rs (reduce, reuse, recycle), yard waste composting, safe disposal of household hazardous waste and of course, garbage disposal.

Please secure all open loads with a tarp or rope.
All customers are to report to the Scalehouse upon arrival.

Fees

For general waste and use of the Container Station, the user fees are:

up to 50 kg	\$5/load
51 kg -150 kg	\$10/load
over 150 kg	10.8 cents/kg starting from 0 kg

Blue Boxes & Backyard Composters

Blue Boxes and Backyard Composters are available at the Scalehouse.

- Blue Boxes:** new residents two free of charge, current residents one free of charge, \$5 per additional box (3 maximum)
- Backyard Composters:** \$15 each (2 maximum)



Salvation Army Drop-off

Drop-off unwanted reusable items for no fee and help the community.

- Acceptable Items:** clothing, linens, paired shoes, kitchenware, toys and undamaged furniture.
- Not Accepted:** cabinets, desks, typewriters, barbeques, tires, auto parts, mattresses, cribs and car seats.



Household Hazardous Waste Depot

Residential hazardous waste can damage the environment if disposed of improperly; it must not be put in the garbage or poured down the drain. Each year the Household Hazardous Waste Depot recycles or properly disposes over 750,000 litres of residential hazardous waste.



Accepted free of charge:

- Aerosol cans (full)
- Automobile batteries
- Fluorescent bulbs and tubes (8 maximum)
- Fuels
- Garden chemicals
- Household batteries
- Household cleaners
- Motor oil and filters
- Paint
- Pesticides
- Pool chemicals
- Pharmaceuticals (over-the-counter and prescription)
- Propane tanks
- Solvents
- Varsol (clean or used)

There is a 20 litre maximum per visit. No commercial hazardous waste can be accepted.

Empty paint cans (dry with lids removed) and other empty containers (with no liquid or powder residue) can be disposed of with regular garbage.

Paint Reuse Shed

Looking for paint to repaint your house? Pick up usable paint and stain at the Reuse Shed for free—we can't guarantee which colours will be available. The Paint Reuse Shed is conveniently located beside the Household Hazardous Waste Depot. Open from spring to fall.



Container Station

In addition to garbage disposal, the following materials are collected and diverted from landfill:


- Yard waste
- Scrap Metal
- Appliances
- Tires (up to 5 per year per household)
- Wood
- Drywall
- Electronics (computer hard drives, stereos, VCRs, etc.)



Additional items may be diverted at the container station free of charge:

- Blue Box materials (free of charge for residential loads only; all commercial loads are subject to charge)
- Cell phones
- Eyeglasses
- Printer cartridges
- Wine and champagne bottle corks (natural corks only)

The Landfill Gas Collection and Utilization Project is a partnership between Halton Region and Oakville Hydro to collect landfill gas to produce electricity. The project provides enough "green" energy to power approximately 1,500 homes. Removing landfill gas from the landfill both reduces odours and cuts down the emission of ozone-depleting methane into the atmosphere, improving the environment.
