Trio facing gambling charges

Three Halton Hills residents have been charged by the OPP Organized Crime Section, Illegal Gambling Unit after police found two video gambling machines in Bracky's pub on Main St. N.

Police found the machines about 11 a.m. Thursday.

Charged with keep machines for gambling in contravention of the criminal code is Ronald Orton, 49, of Georgetown, Dave Wallace of Georgetown and Denean Jones, 43, of Acton.

Halton Police report officers saw a vehicle driving erratically in the Guelph St./ Sinclair Ave. area at about 2:20 a.m. Friday, and pulled over the driver.

Charged with impaired driving and having over 80 mg of alcohol in 100 ml of blood is Christopher James McHugh, 26, of John St.

Two women are facing charges after police received numerous complaints about people selling produce in the Steeles Ave./Winston Churchill Blvd. area resulting in traffic problems.

After warning the vendors previously, police paid them a visit Friday afternoon to lay a charge under a Halton Region bylaw that restricts the sale of goods on a regional road. When the officers spoke to two women at the scene they were shoved.

Charged with obstruct police, assault with intent to resist arrest, and offer goods for sale on a regional road, is Annmarie Wilks, 32, of Bach Rd., Brampton and Nicola Wilks, 33, of Spillsbury Dr., Peterborough.

A Brampton man has been charged in connection with an attempted break and enter at a gas station on Hornby Rd. that occurred overnight June 14/15.

Charged with break and enter with intent to commit an indictable offence is Douglas Payne, 39, of Beech Ave., Brampton.

Police are investigating a break and enter into the compound at Rona Lumber Distribution Centre on Steeles Ave. sometime between Friday and Tuesday. A hole was cut in the chain link fence to gain entry. Nothing was taken.

Motorcyclist seriously hurt

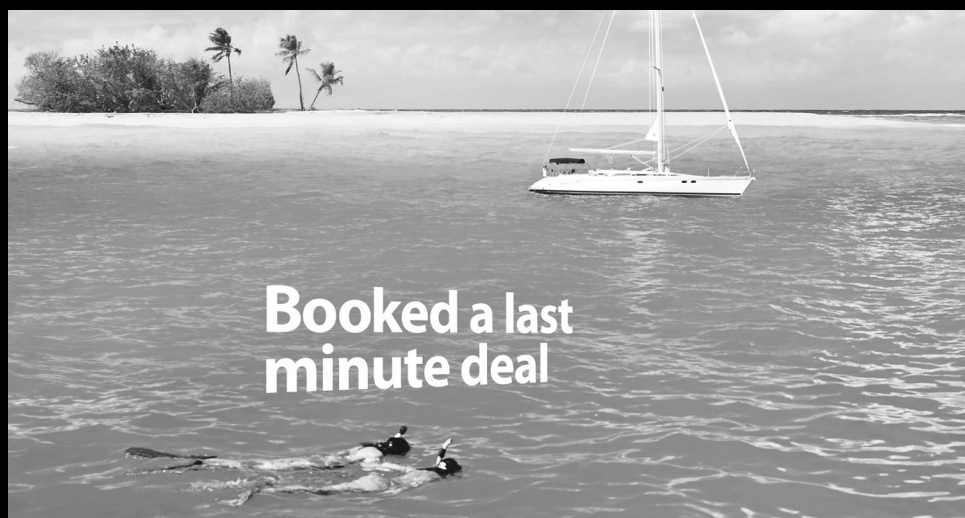
A 29-year-old Georgetown man was seriously injured about 9 p.m. Monday when the motorcycle he was riding was involved in a collision with a Ford Escape at the intersection of Mountainview and Argyll Roads.

When police arrived, the man on the bike was lying in the middle of the intersection. He was taken to Georgetown Hospital where he was stabilized and later rushed by ambulance to Hamilton General Hospital for further treatment.

Police say he suffered a fractured leg, pelvis and wrist. Yesterday (Tuesday) he was listed in serious but stable condition.

The driver of the Escape, a 35-year-old Georgetown woman, wasn't injured.

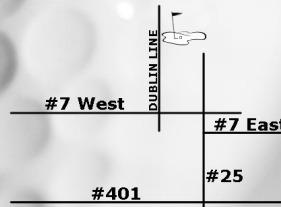
