# Town forced to deal with growth issue

Recently, the Region of Halton released five regional growth concept maps involving a growth period from 2021-2031, and a series of related questions for discussion and response from the Town, all as a result of the Province's Places To Grow Plan where Halton Region's population is legislated to grow by 68 per cent by the year 2032.

This is a planning exercise that I feel we were dragged into kicking and screaming. Now we have to deal with it.

This is Phase Two of a four-phase study known as Sustainable Halton that began in 2006; produced a large volume of background information during 2007; and is expected to be completed by June, 2009.

The five regional concepts, which were reduced from nine, will be reduced to about three this fall, with a preferred regional growth concept being released for public consultation by the Region in early 2009.

The Town has produced a series of reports throughout Phases 1 and 2 that have resulted in input during the process. The most recent release was a discussion paper on August 11.

The Town hosted a workshop Monday at the Gellert Community Centre. Council will have a special meeting Sept. 24 to discuss the growth concepts.

The Georgetown Allotment Gardens are officially open. The Allotment Gardens have been developed in conjunction with the Town and the Georgetown Allotment Group.
