

An opening reception with the artists (including recipients of the Order of Canada and the Order of Ontario), will be held Friday night, 7-10 p.m. The show will continue until October 13.

CONSTRUCTION OF AN ANAEROBIC DIGESTER, GEORGETOWN WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, TOWN OF HALTON HILLS (GEORGETOWN)

Halton Region is planning to construct a new, third anaerobic digester at the Georgetown Wastewater Treatment Plant in the Town of Halton Hills (Georgetown). The new digester will not expand the overall rated treatment capacity of the facility, but will increase the solids stabilization capacity to match the existing liquid treatment capacity. Construction is due to begin in 2009.

You are invited to attend a Public Information Centre to learn about the planned construction and discuss any concerns you may have with representatives from Halton Region. This Public Information Centre will be an informal meeting and you are invited to drop in at your convenience between the noted hours.
