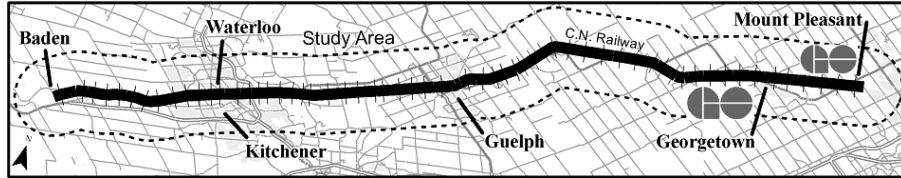

### GEORGETOWN TO KITCHENER RAIL EXPANSION

#### THE STUDY

GO Transit, the Province of Ontario's inter-regional public transit service for the Greater Toronto and Hamilton areas, is undertaking a Preliminary Design Study and Class Environmental Assessment to expand rail services from Georgetown to Kitchener. The Study will identify passenger demand for the extended service, track improvements, stations and storage facilities, park and ride facilities and integration with local transit.
