Ryan Thomson, 16, looked poised for a late charge but a couple of double bogeys on the back nine of the second round scuttled any chances of victory as he placed tied for third overall at +11, three shots behind the boys' 14-16 champion from the Netherlands.

Eleven-year-old Samantha Spencer of Georgetown South com-

peted against some high school seniors in the open girls' division, which was her first-ever CJGA junior tournament, yet she was fourth out of eight golfers after rounds of 101-99.

Also in the boys' 14-16 category, Josh Hale of Georgetown was 17th at +27 and Acton's Andrew Tressell finished 26th at +34.
