Q: What can help get rid of canker sores?

A: Are you one of those unfortunate folks who frequently develop canker sores? You're not alone. This condition is actually a small ulcer which forms in the lining of the mouth or the tongue. It happens to people of all ages, though more commonly in children. Most authorities believe the ulcer is the result of a virus attacking the membranes inside the mouth.
One of the better ways to prevent canker sores is to avoid breaking surface tissue inside the mouth. A break often occurs with an accidental biting of the mouth lining, sometimes resulting in a canker sore. Typically this sore lasts from eight to ten days. Dentists sometimes treat canker sores to quicken their disappearance.
To most of us, canker sores will develop and remain an annoyance no matter what we do. Rest assured, though, your dentist can provide invaluable assistance to you with this and all your dental needs.

Q: Is my wife's jewellery automatically covered by my home insurance policy or do I need a separate policy?

A: In most home, condominium, and tenants policies there is some coverage for jewellery provided automatically in the special limits of insurance section of the policy. However, the amount of coverage provided in this section is limited. Depending on the insurer and the coverage form selected it could range from \$1,000.00 to \$5,000.00 and in the event of a claim will be subject to the deductible on the homeowner's policy, and to various restrictions of coverage.
To better protect valuables like jewellery it should be scheduled on a floater form. Floaters are attached to the policy for an additional premium and are designed to provide broader coverage, higher limits of insurance, and lower deductibles. When scheduling jewellery on a floater a current appraisal is required from a reputable jeweler. The appraisal should provide a detailed description of the jewellery including a photograph and value of the item.
Whenever you have a question about what is covered in your home insurance policy, a telephone call or visit to your insurance broker is always a good idea. Remember an independent insurance broker works for you, not the insurance company.
