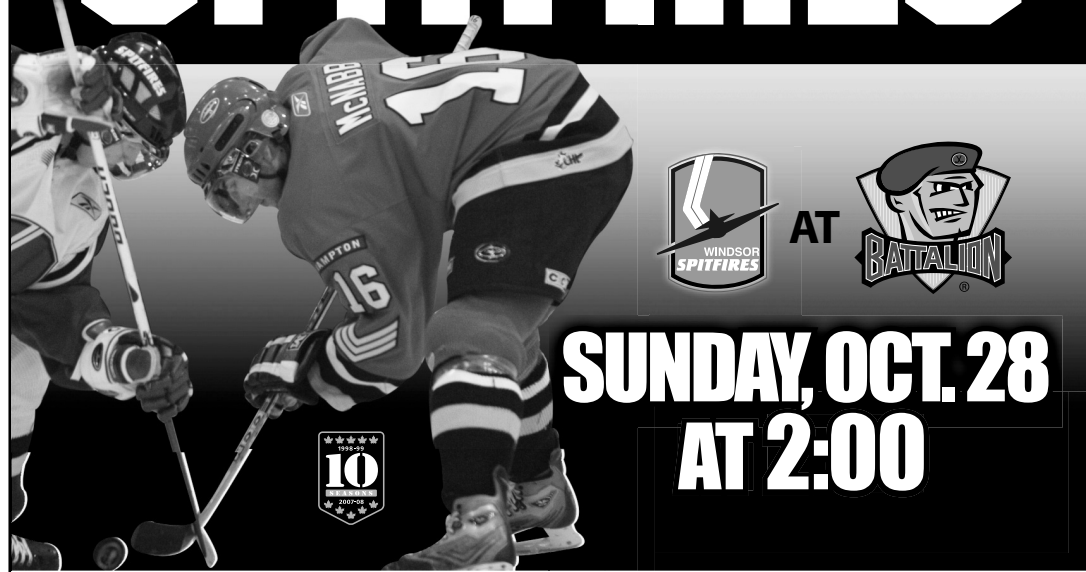
The 3-2 Rebels were held scoreless at halftime by winless Abbey Park but broke the game open in the third quarter.
