Remembrance services: Royal Canadian Legion Branch 120 (Georgetown) holds its annual Remembrance Day Parade and ceremony.

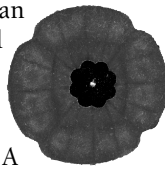
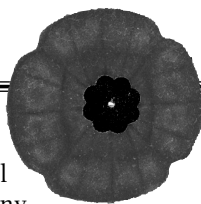
