#### PROPOSAL

The Town of Caledon proposes to delete section 5.17.3, and make any other necessary modifications, in the Town of Caledon Official Plan, that deal with specific Community Improvement Plan areas namely, Bolton Core, Alton Core, and Bolton Industrial Parks.

#### PURPOSE AND EFFECT OF THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The purpose of the application is to leave only the policies outlining the objectives, criteria, and methods of implementation for a Community Improvement Plan. The effect of the proposal is to provide for more flexibility within the Official Plan, allowing various communities of Caledon to be able to use these policies for their particular needs for a potential Community Improvement Plan.

#### NOTIFICATION

If you wish to be notified of the adoption of the proposed Official Plan Amendment you must make a written request to the Town of Caledon, Planning and Development Department, 6311 Old Church Road, Caledon, Ontario L7C 1J6.

#### APPEAL PROCEDURES

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Caledon before the Official Plan is approved, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision of the Town of Caledon to the Ontario Municipal Board.

If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the Town of Caledon before the Official Plan is approved, the person or public body may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.
