

Trail renamed; bike plan reviewed

The Town of Halton Hills has renamed the Trafalgar Trail that runs from the Civic Centre through Trafalgar Country, Moore Park, the Fairgrounds and back, as the Chris Walker Memorial Trail.

The late Chris Walker, a Georgetown nature enthusiast, made a significant contribution in promoting and building trails and trail linkages in Halton Hills and Ontario through his involvement with the Bruce Trail Association. Walker was also a member of the Town's trails committee.

Council will spend \$600 from its own contingency account to buy the recognition signage and plaques.

review, and possibly update, the Town's cycling plan.


The committee will include members of the public as well as council. Wards 3&4 Regional Councillor Jane Fogal, an avid cyclist herself, brought forward the motion citing the increased interest in cycling and the increasing conflict with public on safety issues. With the growth in the town, Fogal stated it was time to review the plan.

"We've got a plan out there, but we haven't made any progress at implementing it," she said.

"I would like an ad hoc committee set up to start to get some action on it. I know there's been a lot of letters to the editor (in *The Independent & Free Press*) about (bike) safety in the community... we don't have proper signage or lanes. This is to address this issue."
