The Feud television series is looking for participants.

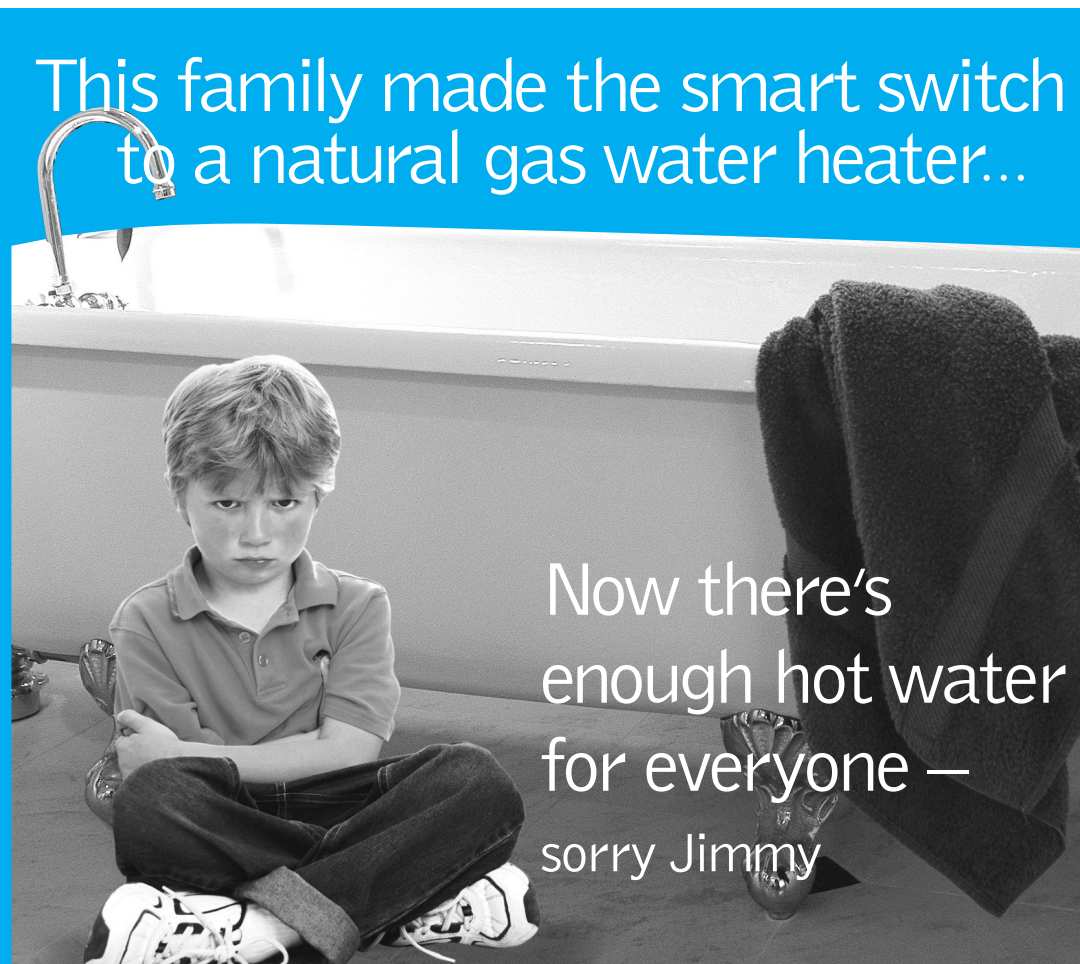
