Vujnovic will drop down to the welterweight class (170 pounds) for Friday night's encounter and spent hours in the sauna beforehand in order to lighten up for the weigh-in, but he'll have regained most of those lost pounds by the time the bell rings to start the proceedings. The Georgetown District High School grad said that he became interested in mixed martial arts after watching the Ultimate Fighting shows on television and originally began training at Boreland's gym on Armstrong Ave. just to get in shape, not necessarily to become a professional fighter.

"I remember the first guy I sparred with at the

gym weighed about 140 pounds and he took me apart in no time," recalled Vujnovic, who uses his farmhouse reach and massive hands to neutralize his opponent on the mat.

"That really motivated me and showed me what it was going to take to be successful at this, and I won't ever forget that. The training that's involved is quite a bit, but I think it's worth it. I run all over town, during the winter even, to stay in shape."
