Playing with Danger?



Protect your child from dangerous situations on the playground by raising awareness of these common yet dangerous conditions:

- Exposed concrete foundations, roots or rocks pose tripping hazards.
- Sharp edges, protruding bolts or open "S" hooks can scratch or puncture.
- Drawstrings on clothing or ropes used for play can cause accidental strangulation.
- Spaces which could trap children, such as guardrails or ladder rungs, should measure less than 32" and more than 9" apart.
