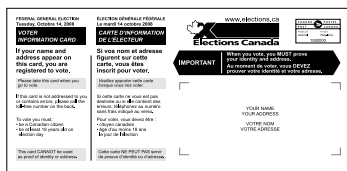

**You will find the voting hours for your polling station on your voter information card or at [www.elections.ca](http://www.elections.ca) by clicking on "Voter Information Service".**

**If you haven't received this card, you are probably not on the voters list. To register, all you need to do is go to your polling station on election day, where you must prove your identity and address.**

**New identification rules to vote**

When you vote, you must prove your identity and address.

For the list of acceptable pieces of identification authorized by the Chief Electoral Officer of Canada, please see the pamphlet you received by mail from Elections Canada or visit [www.elections.ca](http://www.elections.ca) and click on "Voter Identification at the Polls".

- To vote, you must:
- be a Canadian citizen
  - be at least 18 years old on election day
  - prove your identity and address
