Information sessions for well users

Halton Region Health Dept. is holding two well water information sessions for residents who use private wells, the first at Limehouse Memorial Hall on Thursday, April 20 (tonight). The second session will be held on Thursday, April 27 at the Nassagaweya Community Centre, Guelph Line, Brookville.

Residents can drop in any time between 3p.m. and 9p.m. at both sessions.

Residents attending the information sessions have an opportunity to:

- Talk to public health Inspectors about well water quality concerns;
- Talk to professional well drillers from the Ontario Ground Water Association;
- Have water tested for nitrate (bring one cup of water in a sterilized jar);
- Learn about water treatment systems used to improve water quality;
- Review well water records from the Halton Region's database;
- Drop off private well water samples to be sent to the Public Health Lab for bacteriological testing (samples can only be accepted when in the proper sampling bottles supplied by Halton Region).

The Candle Light March will be held on Thursday, May 4. Those of you with eagle eyes will have noticed the challenge put out last week by Peggy Harris, LA president.

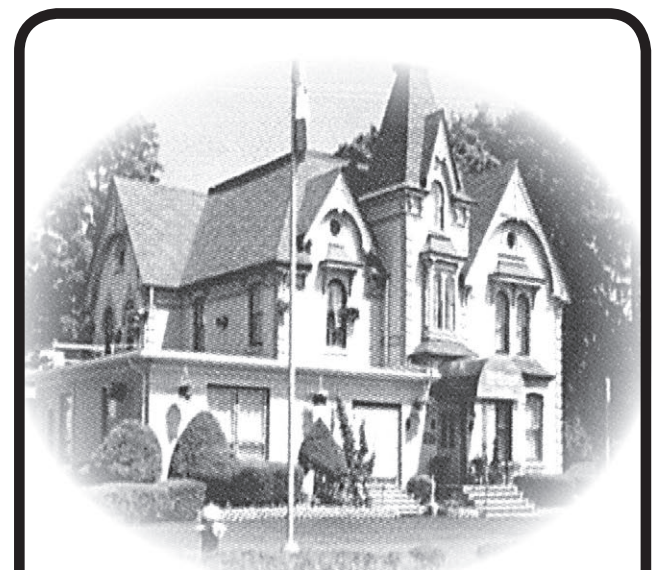
