"We've also identified another \$400,000 in asks that we that we're going to be making over the next few weeks," he said adding of the 36 donations to date, the average is \$11,774 - a real tribute to the community.

Earlier in the meeting, Acton Councillor Mike O'Leary said at the request of the donor, the name of the company that pledged an additional \$80,000 on Tuesday – described as one of the major industrial firms in Acton – will not be released for several weeks.

O'Leary noted that the company had already pledged \$20,000 to the building campaign, raising the total

Council also agreed to waive build permit fees and other related development fees, estimated at under

Mayor Rick Bonnette said it was "just unbelievable" that Society fundraisers have been able to collect pledges and cash totaling almost half-a-million dollars in three short months.

Based on a timeline that allows four weeks for finalization of the financial documents, site plan approval and issuing of permits, resulting in a construction beginning in early to mid-October with the building finished in May or June with an official grand opening for the 2007 Acton Fall Fair.

A highlight of this year's fair will be the groundbreaking ceremony for the new building, slated for 2 p.m. on September 16.


