Firefighter hurt


An injured off-duty firefighter used his cell phone to call for help from inside his smashed vehicle following a two-vehicle accident on Highway 25, north of 10 Side Road at 1:43 p.m. on August 29.

Police said a southbound

vehicle slowed to make a left turn into a private driveway and collided with a northbound vehicle.

The southbound vehicle rolled and hit a sign on the opposite side of the highway; the driver, a 20-year-old Mississauga woman, received minimal injuries and a passenger was not hurt. She was charged with making an unsafe turn.
