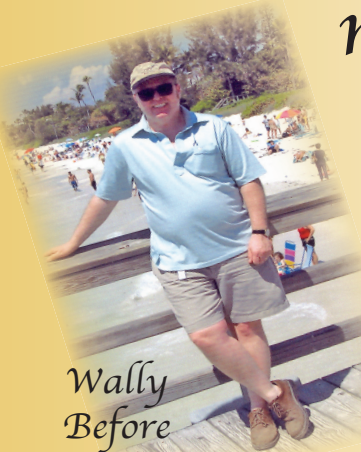

TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ELECTION 2006 ARE YOU ON THE VOTERS LIST?

The voters' list will be posted at the Town of Halton Hills, Civic Centre, 1 Halton Hills Drive, commencing Tuesday, September 5, 2006.

Electors should examine the list to ensure that their names and relevant information are correctly shown.

Any individual may call the Town Clerk's Office during regular office hours at 905-873-2601 x 2330, to make inquiries regarding their status as an elector and their school support.

A PERSON MAY MAKE APPLICATION REQUESTING THAT:

1. his/her name be added to or removed from the voters' list or
2. information on the voters' list relating to the person be amended

between Tuesday, September 5, 2006 and Friday, November 10, 2006 at the Clerk's Office or on Voting Day, November 13, 2006 at the location designated for you to vote.

A PERSON MAY MAKE APPLICATION REQUESTING THAT:

3. another person's name be deleted from the voters' list by filing an application on the prescribed form with the Clerk at the Civic Centre

between Tuesday, September 5, 2006 and Friday, September 29, 2006.

VOTING PROXIES

Any elector may appoint another eligible elector as his or her proxy. The forms to appoint a proxy are available at the Town Clerk's Office after October 3, 2006. The individual who is to be appointed as the proxy must attend the Town Clerk's Office in order to take a declaration.

An individual may act as a proxy for only one individual. This restriction on the number of appointments does not apply if the individual is acting as a proxy for a spouse, sibling, parent, child, grandparent, or grandchild.
