

Major road work almost complete

By mid-November paving crews will finish laying base and topcoats of fresh black asphalt on long stretches

of Acton roads, wrapping up almost \$2-million of badly-needed repairs and underground pipe replacement work.

Weather permitting, the Town will pave Eastern Avenue and York Street next week, about three weeks behind schedule according to Ron Goddard, manager of Engineering Design and Capital Works.

throughout the whole project," Goddard said, adding vandals caused a one-week delay when they broke a temporary water connection to homes and businesses in the area.

The Eastern/York work budget was \$807,000.

Curb work and sidewalk construction is complete along Eastern, and this week, the curbs will be constructed on York so all of the paving can be done in two or three days beginning next week.

Goddard said crews are finalizing the grading on Bower Avenue, St. Alban's Drive and Willow Street in preparation for paving next week – weather permitting.

"The weather hasn't cooperated, but we were able to maintain open access for businesses and residents

That \$1-million pavement management project also included McDonald Boulevard, Norman Avenue and Acton Boulevard.

Firefighters checked for any problems and helped the tenant reset the alarm.
