The Ontario Energy Board licenses all natural gas marketers and electricity retailers. They must conduct their business using "Fair Marketing Practices" which includes that the retailer representative "immediately and truthfully" identifies who they are and which company they represent; that the representatives wear photo I.D. listing the name of their company; and that they do not pressure you, the consumer, to sign a contract.

Any issues or concerns should be reported directly to the Ontario Energy Board. Providing the Ontario Energy Board with the date and time of the incident along with the name of the salesperson and the company they represent will be helpful.
