rain has fallen, unseasonably dry weather this spring, combined with heavy water use, has prompted Halton to request that residents minimize outdoor water use, including lawn watering, car washing and driveway washing. Flower and vegetable gardens should be watering ban. watered by hand and only as needed.

Halton's Planning and Public Works staff is monitoring the Region's reservoir levels closely. If the hot, dry weather persists, it may become necessary to issue a complete

Halton Region has an odd-even day watering by-law in effect which advises that even-numbered houses should water only on even calendar days and odd-numbered housed should water only on odd calendar days. However, since lawns only need one inch of water once a week to stay healthy, it is not necessary to water on every odd or even day, regional officials say.
