An 18-year-old Kingham Road male was arrested last Thursday night in connection with the June 30 assault of a 17-year-old Acton male who suffered broken and chipped teeth in the attack.

Police said the suspect was charged with assault causing bodily harm as he was stopped while driving in Acton on Thursday night.

Police said the assault occurred in the Duby Road/ Kingham Road area when the accused got out of his car and punched the victim, who was walking in the area, several times in the face.

The victim was able to partially identify his attacker. Police would not say what led to the attack.
