show starts at 2 p.m.

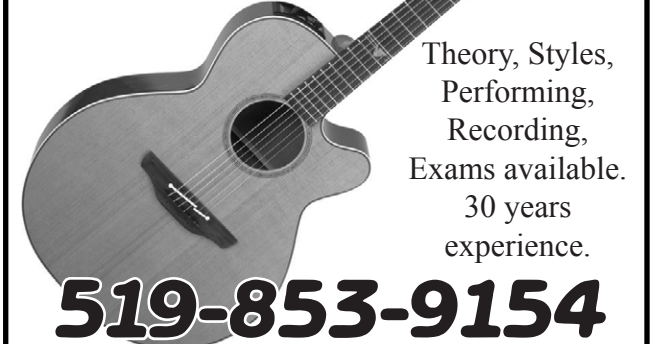
The Niagara Casino is on Wednesday, Sept. 5, and I have already mentioned the St. Lawrence Market trip.
