Halton has questions for candidates

Halton Regional Chair Gary Carr is asking candidates running in the October 10th Provincial election to tell voters how they will resolve critical issues facing Halton as part of the Fairness for Halton campaign. Candidates are being asked to respond to a questionnaire by September 24. The ques-

tions and all answers received from the candidates will be posted on the Region's website.

"We developed the Fairness for Halton campaign to respond to the Province's Places to Grow Plan, which is asking Halton to double its population over the next 25

years," said Chair Carr. "Halton currently has a \$300 million municipal infrastructure deficit, and the Provincial growth targets will require an additional \$8.6 billion in municipal and Provincial infrastructure. As a result we need predictable, committed Continued on Page 2

Gate receipts are well over **2006 record**

It was another recordbreaking year financially for the Acton Fall Fair, the result of an increase in admission, and thousands who flocked to the fair over three days of special events.

The presence of the new Agricultural Society building, replacing the old Acton arena, got "absolutely rave reviews" one member of the Fair Board told The New Tanner, as well as attracting many more exhibits in the homecraft division.

"People were stopping members of the agricultural society to congratulate them on the new building," said one official. One couple from North Bay, former Actonians, are even considering making a donation, he said.

The level of exhibits increased substantially and attractions such as the lawn garden pull, drew over 100 entries. It was the same all over the grounds which swelled with fairgoers on Saturday and Sun-
