Don't Waste Your Pumpkins

In urban areas, put pumpkins in with your yard waste. Other acceptable yard waste materials include: decorative corn stalks, fallen fruit from trees, yard and garden trimmings and tree trimmings.

Use only paper yard waste bags, or labelled, reusable, rigid containers with no lids. Drill holes in the bottom of reusable containers to prevent water from gathering. Yard waste labels for reusable containers are available at no charge from Halton Region. Containers must be no larger than 125 L (27 imperial gallons) or 23 kg (50 lbs).

Yard waste materials will be collected every other week on the same day as your Blue Box until December 7.
