# Firefighter pucksters, Leaf Alumni clash in cancer games

Toronto Maple Leafs Alumni allegedly outscored Halton Hills Firefighters in their recent Charity game at Alcott Arena. The three stars? Number three: Steve Thomas, still with a magical shot and still too good for the American League. Number two: The most beautiful sound in nature not made by loons at sundown – the hypnotic rhythm of tape to tape passes of endless variety and skill. And the First Star: a tidy sum raised for C.A.S.H. -Cancer Assistance Services of Halton, thanks to the organizational efforts of Kevin Usher and many volunteers.
