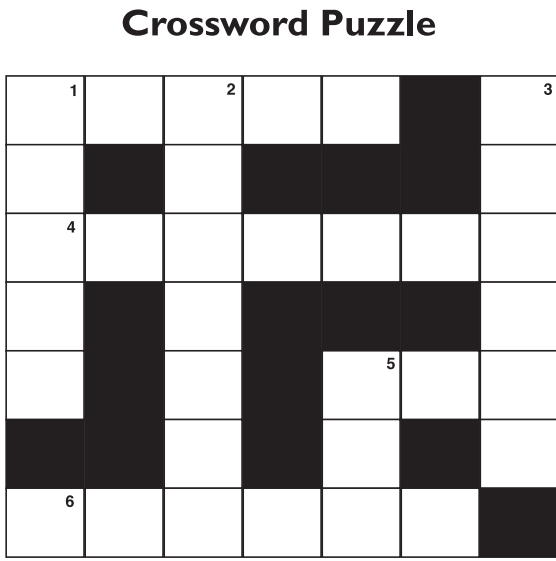

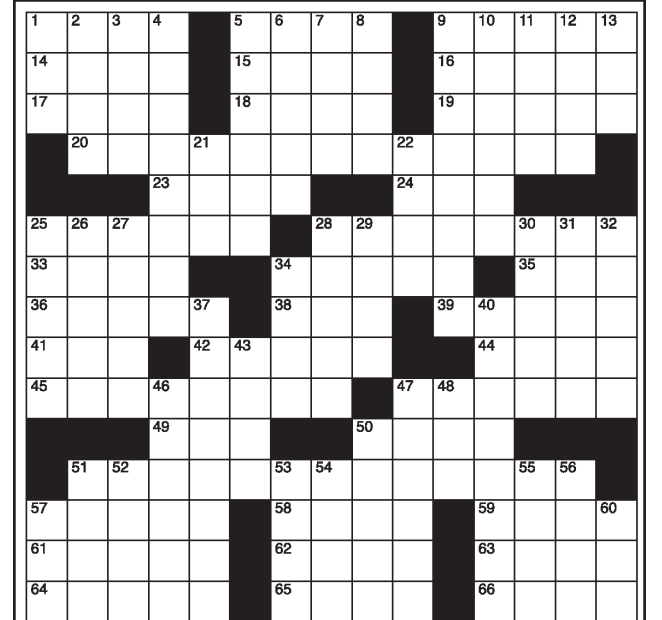
HISTORY
