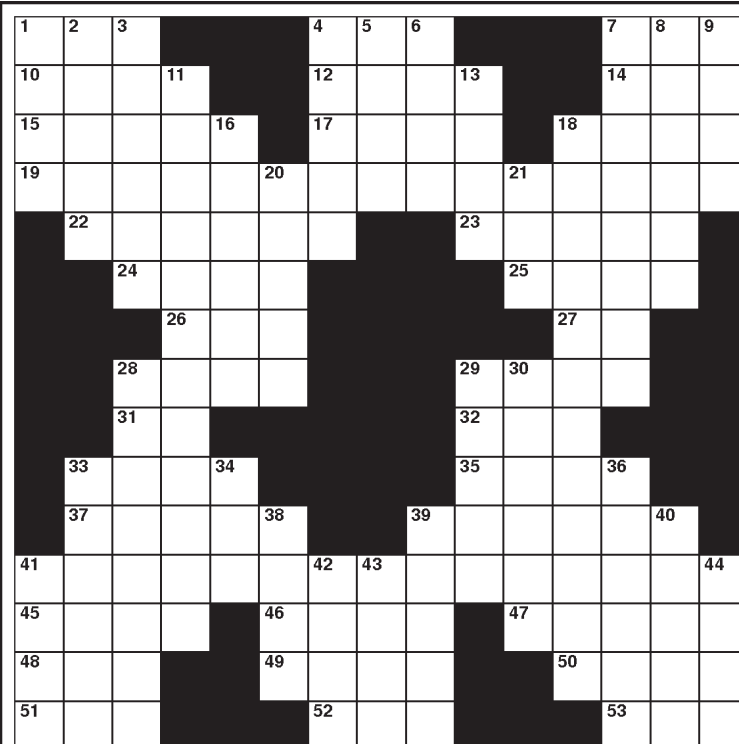
HISTORY

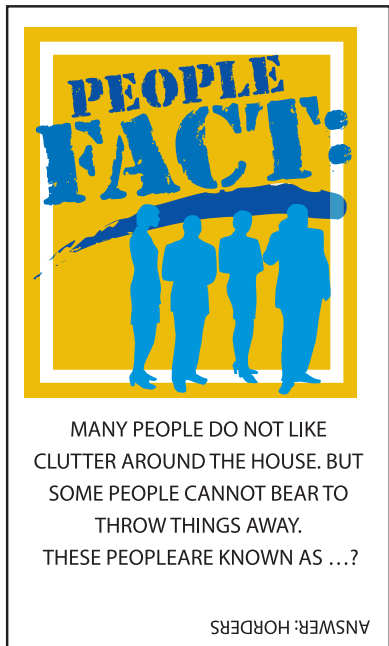
