

Acton girl burned in freak accident

A 15-year old Acton girl is recovering from second degree burns on her chin and neck after a freak accident at the Acton KFC restaurant on Saturday.

Kendell Lakin suffered an epileptic seizure and fell face-first into her order of hot poutine. Customers rushed to her

side and called 911. She was taken to hospital and treated.

Her father was reportedly not impressed with the response from KFC officials who said government food standards require gravy meals to be served at between 140 and 165 degrees Fahrenheit.
