**Holmesway work**

Replacement of the waste water main under Cobblehill Road – a \$162,000 project – will be added to Halton's list of projects to do this year to coincide with the Town's plan to resurface the street.

Although the project was not included in Halton's budget, members of the Planning and Public Works committee voted to add it, and two other projects, to the budget so both the Region's and Town's work could be done at the same time.

To pay for the work, three other projects – two in Oakville and one in Georgetown – will be deferred until budget debates next year. Halton Council was expected to approve the plan at its meeting yesterday (Wednesday.)
